

<u>Aim:</u> The Field Visit to Agricultural College NAIRA aims to provide students with practical exposure and hands-on learning in the fields of Agriculture, Horticulture, and Scientific research.

Brief Note on Activity: Agricultural College, Naira, was established on 7th August 1989 to meet the increasing demand for agricultural education in North Coastal Andhra Pradesh. Naira, a village in Srikakulam district, is located six km from the nearest railway station, Srikakulam Road, on the East Coast Railway. The college focuses on agricultural research, education, and extension services, addressing the region's diverse soils, unique cropping patterns, and climatic conditions. With advanced research facilities, it promotes modern farming techniques and supports farmers in enhancing agricultural productivity and sustainability.

The Field Visit to Naira was organized to provide students with practical exposure to modern agricultural techniques and enhance their understanding of scientific advancements in farming. The visit commenced at 9:00 AM with a journey to Naira, and students arrived at the site by 10:00 AM.

The visit began with a field exploration session from 10:00 AM to 11:00 AM, where students observed different new crop varieties such as rice, mango, coconut, and intermediate crops belonging to the Fabaceae family. Experts explained the characteristics of these varieties and their significance in improving crop yield and sustainability.

After a lunch break from 1:00 PM to 2:00 PM, students explored Horticulture Units, including Greenhouse and Polyhouse, Here, they learned about various fruit, vegetable, and ornamental plant cultivation practices, modern horticultural techniques such as protected cultivation, hydroponics, and drip irrigation. The controlled environment of these structures was explained as a way to enhance crop growth and efficiency.

The final session, from 3:00 PM to 5:00 PM, included a visit to the Department Labs, where students explored the Pathology and Taxonomy Labs. Here, they studied various plant diseases, pest control measures, and plant classification techniques.

The field visit was highly beneficial, providing students with hands-on learning experiences and a deeper understanding of modern agricultural practices. It successfully bridged the gap between theoretical knowledge and real-world applications, equipping students with practical insights into sustainable farming.

Objectives:

- 1. To provide hands-on experience in modern agricultural practices and sustainable farming methods.
- 2. To study various crop varieties, including rice, mango, coconut, and Fabaceae family crops.
- 3. To understand advanced horticultural techniques using greenhouses, polyhouses, and hydroponics.
- 4. To explore organic farming through vermiculture, mushroom cultivation, and composting techniques.
- 5. To gain knowledge of plant diseases, pest control, and classification in pathology and taxonomy labs.

Outcomes:

- 1. Students experienced real-world agricultural practices and their importance.






