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FIELD VISIT AT TELINEELAPURAM ON 08-12-2023



A Field visit to Telineelapuram Bird Sanctuary organized by the Science Association for the benefit of final year B.Sc (BZC,MPC, MPCs) students to Tekkali on 8th December ,2023 along with the staff members

BRIEF REPORT: Telineelapuram Bird Sanctuary are located in Srikakulam district of Andhra Pradesh, India. Telineelapuram is a village located 65 kilometers from Srikakulam in Tekkali mandal. Every year, over 3,000 pelicans and painted storks visit from Siberia to these villages during September and stay on till March.

The Tekkali creek and the villages in its vicinity like Telineelapuram, Ijjuvaram, Naupada in the district have become a seasonal resort for the winged tourists coming from as far as Siberia in Russia, Malaysia, Hungary, Singapore and Germany apart from 113 different species of inland birds, a majority of which are migrants from other states.

Siberian birds, particularly the Siberian cranes and other migratory species, embark on long journeys to escape the harsh Siberian winters. They travel thousands of kilometers to reach warmer regions, such as parts of India, including Telineelapuram in Andhra Pradesh. These birds are known for their striking plumage and impressive stamina. Observing them offers insights into migratory patterns and ecological balance. Conservation efforts are crucial for their survival, as they face threats from habitat loss and climate change. The presence of Siberian birds in wintering grounds underscores the interconnectedness of global ecosystems and the need for international cooperation in wildlife preservation.
