
### DATA ANALYSIS:

Out of 50 people 22 were males and 28 were females. Majority of the people, 31 (72%) respond that they people, 31 (72%) response of brush their teeth daily, and response of 79 (28%), was that they are not used to drush their teeth on daily basis. Only, 23 \$46%) people brush teeth once a time and proper maintain washrooms.
