The Parties shall use their best efforts to settle amicably all disputes arising out of or in connection with this Agreement or the interpretation thereof. If any dispute, difference, question or disagreement arises between the Parties hereto or their respective representatives or assignees, in connection with construction, meaning operation, effect interpretation of the Agreement or breach thereof which Parties are unable to settle mutually within 30 days from the commencement of settlement proceedings and if not settled then the same shall be referred to the court of Andhra Pradesh Jurisdiction.

TERMINATION

This MoU may be terminated on expiry of the stipulated period or by giving a notice of one month or the conclusion of ongoing programs, whichever is later, from either side. This memorandum which is in 03 pages is signed on 1st February, 2023 and exchanged on 1st February, 2023.
