CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

The students are instructed to maintain discipline in the college by adhering rules and regulations of the college for maintaining a healthy learning environment.

All the students shall attend the college wearing the valid identity card issued by the college.

All the students must keep the college premises, classrooms, and washrooms clean. Dustbins must be used for throwing garbage.

Use of mobile phones in the classrooms, library and college premises is strictly prohibited.

Students shall not cause any damage to the college property like disfiguring the walls, doors, windows and breaking of furniture will be considered a punishable offence.

Ragging is an offence and is strictly prohibited in the college and any student involved in ragging will be expelled from the college.
