- Emphasize the importance of hygiene, personal and community health and recognize their interrelationship;
- .Discuss the role of immunity in preventing diseases;
- .Express awareness about the national immunization programme and how it prevents certain communicable diseases;

Community Awareness service

We conducted community awareness programme in the July 2022 month of community service project. The following issues we observed.

- 1. Many people in the sample area depending on agriculture status and not maintained personal hygiene.
- 2. Some people illiteracy condition and not proper maintenance colony surround hygiene conditions.
- 3. Many people not concentrate seasonal diseases.
- 4. Male population genders effects in common diseases.
- 5. Many people not personal health care.

MATERIALS AND METHODS:

A health education intervention study was conducted from JULY 2022 in a rural area of Cheedipudi Village, Saravakota, Srikakulam, and Andhra Pradesh. The individuals were selected by multistage random sampling and interviewed using a structured questionnaire. After a baseline Health and hygiene assessment, intervention activities were conducted twice. The intervention activities were group level talks and discussions, free sanitation kits distribution, and display of health maintain posters at anganwadi centers.

PRIMARY DATA

The primary data was collected by means of a survey. Questionnaires were prepared individual economical social status survey.

Primary Data is used by issuing a questionnaire to 30 respondents Socio Economic Survey asking implementation and impact personal and social welfare schemes Edulavalasa and recorded the responses out of 30 respondents.

SECONDARY DATA

The data gathered for the study mainly of secondary nature .It was gathered from the official websites of World Health Organization and Wikipedia.

In order to have a proper understanding a depth study was done from the various sources such s books and the articles from various search engines like Google, Yahoo search answers.com.


<u>DATA ANALYSIS:</u>

Some of (Male 60% people 32 the Female40%) responded that they used tobacco products. Most people(95%) responded that they take Covid Vaccine. As well, 34 (58%) participants answered that they did not know the importance of seasonal disease Realth care. 





 - We suggest Daily proper maintain
 - 1. Brush your teeth, cut your nails
 - 2. Have a bath daily, wear clean clothes
 - 3. Eat nutritious food
 - 4. Have regular eating habits
 - 5. Follow a disciplined life
 - 6. Exercise regularly
 - 7. Use of mosquito net
 - 8. Sanitary condition and proper disposal of human excreta
 - 9. Cover your cough, sneeze
 - 10. to take BCG vaccine
- The following are some of the personal hygiene activities that we recommended:
- Taking daily baths: Bathing regularly and wearing clean clothes.
- Dirt is a place for germs to grow. So bathing regularly keeps your body free of dirt and germs. This is particularly important in climates that make people sweat a lot.
- Regular toilet habits: Regular bowel movements keep us free of wastes generated inside our body. Develop this habit in your children by giving them the right food, plenty of water and by making them do proper exercises.

Washing and cleaning our feet when you return home. This

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- washes off the germs collected from outside. In traditional homes in Kerala, a
 special vessel filled with water is kept at the doorstep to wash feet thoroughly
 before entering the home. This is a good
- practice that ensures domestic and personal hygiene. Washing your feet and drying them, particularly between the toes, before going to bed, and cleaning and regularly clipping the toe nails, helps to keep many germs away from you and your home.
- Brushing your teeth in the morning when you get up and at night before you go to bed. After eating food, some food particles may remain stuck to your teeth. These food particles allow germs to grow, which can harm your gums and teeth, and cause bad breath. Brushing your teeth twice daily and rinsing your mouth every time after food prevents these germs from growing.
- Washing hair, cleaning eyes, nose, ears and nails: Regular washing and combing of hair helps to prevent dirt accumulation, and keeps germs and lice away. Nails should be clipped and cleaned regularly. Nail biting is unhygienic and must be avoided. Wash your eyes and nose daily with clean cold water. Wash your ear lobes and see that your nose and ears are kept clean always. Avoid inserting objects into your ears to clean or scratch your ears as it is dangerous and can lead to deafness.
- Respiratory hygiene: correct respiratory and hand hygiene while coughing and sneezing reduces the spread of germs, particularly during the 'cold and flu' season. Carry tissues and use them to
- cover your mouth and nose when you cough or sneeze. Remember to properly
 dispose them off as soon as possible. Wash your hands thoroughly using soap. If
 soaps or disinfectants are not available, you can use affordable mud or ash as an

alternative.

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Abstain from bad habits: such as smoking, chewing of betel nut, pan and tobacco and drinking of alcohol. Such unhealthy habits may lead to health problems such as liver damage, kidney failure, heart failure, cancer, and mental and social problems. So avoid such habits at all costs.

You can be a role model to your children by following these hygienic practices that keep you healthy.

Hand hygiene: this is one habit that is taken for granted by many. Though very simple, it is a very important activity that can work wonders in keeping you healthy. Hand washing is considered to be the most important step in maintaining hygiene and protecting health.

Always wash your hands before and after handling food. Eating food with dirty hands may make us ill because the dirt in our hands and nails might carry certain disease-causing germs. Teach children to wash their hands thoroughly before and after food, and also after going to the toilet. Washing hands with soap makes them germ free. Use tissues to catch coughs and sneezes, and wash your hands thoroughly afterwards. •
