At the end of her speech she encouraged the students to make the most of these digital resources.

Then a guided tour of the campus was conducted to familiarize the students with key facilities such as the Library, laboratories, sports facilities, gym-room, canteen, skill hub and the play ground. From the second day onwards faculty members from

each department introduce students to the academic structure, course content and evaluation methods and also explaining the expectations we have from the students in terms of attendance, discipline and active participation in class during this period they were also introduced to NCC,NSS and different clubs in the college and also to encourage them to participate in extracurricular activities like sports, cultural and social service clubs which play an important role in their personality development.
