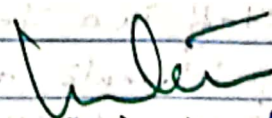

Subsequent to the meetings conducted by the IQAC in the month of December-2023, the following action was taken for the completion of the IQAC initiatives.

1. 2. The IQAC initiated the planning process of inviting the local MLA Shri. Dharmana Krishna Das to have lunch with the visiting NAAC peer to foster a collaborative atmosphere that highlights the college's commitment to quality education and community development. The principal along with the IQAC members invited the Local MLA to demonstrate his support and to enhance the engagement of the peer team with local governance.
3. The IQAC initiated World Computer Literacy Day in collaboration with the Department of Computer Sciences aimed to raise awareness about the importance of computer literacy, improve basic computer skills among students, and reduce the digital divide by equipping participants with essential technological knowledge.

9. The IQAC inspired the students to actively participate in nation building initiatives through registrations in the Viksit Bharat portal.

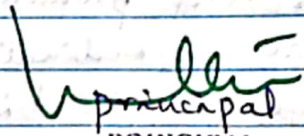

Subsequent to the Meeting conducted in the month of January-2024, the following action was taken to complete the IQAC initiatives.

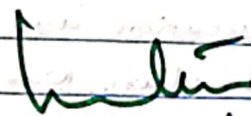

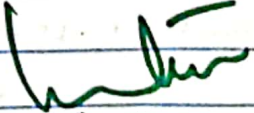

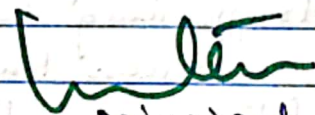
13. The IQAC co-ordinated with all the mentors of the VIth semester students and completed the payment of the Internship fee to the University and updated all the
