Description of the activity	The study field visit (a one day field trip) was organized by the department of zoology, Govt Degree College, Narasannapeta with principal and 5 lecturers, I, II, III Year B.Sc. C.B.Z students of this college to visit entomology department at Acharya N.G.Ranga Agricultural University, Naira College, Amadalavalasa, Srikakulam. The Students Learnt about the economically important insects like Butterflies, Bugs, Honeybees, fruitflies etc and detecting the role of insects which spread disease and discovered various ways of protecting food and fibre crops. The visiting place Naira Agricultural College, Srikakulam has 220 acres of farm area. We were guided by a tour visit by head & Prof Dr.Sanyasi Dhura explained in detail about different species of insects. The students were enlightened with advanced knowledge on the insects biosystematics, physiology and management of insect pests in different fields and horticultural crops and storage grains. They learnt to solve the plant protection problems in agriculture by using biotechnological techniques and tools. All the students recorded their observations during this field visit.
