


Action-Taken Report


Action-Taken Report


Subsequent to the meetings conducted in the month of August the following action was taken for the IQAC initiatives -

October-25


Subsequent to the meetings conducted in the month of October, the following action was taken for the IQAC initiatives.

Subsequent to the meetings conducted in the month of November, the following action was taken for the IQAC initiatives.




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person was Administrative officer Smt. Hima Bindu from the Government Hospital; Balaga, Srikakulam.

12. Vandemataram Song is being played at 9.45 am everyday to commemorate 150 years to it and have adopted it as a proud best practice of the Institute.


